JOINT REGULATION 11 of 1964

JOINT REGULATION

No. 11 of
1964.

Prohibit the alienation of land in the Pango Peninsula, Efate.

Joint Regulation No. 11 of 1964 was published in *Condominium*
Gazette No. 222 and is reprinted as amended by Joint Regulation
No. 21 of 1967 (Gazette No. 259).]

Enacted by the British and French Resident Commissioners under
the provisions of Article 27, paragraph 2 (G) of the Anglo-French
Treaty of 1914.

1. Joint Regulation No. 4 of 1952 is hereby repealed.

2. From and after the date hereof no sale or grant of land at
present in native ownership and situated within the limits of the
Pango Peninsula, as defined in section 3 of this Regulation, and no
sale or grant of interest in any such land, shall be made to any
native: Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to any
sale or grant of land made to the Resident Commissioners, acting
publicly, for reasons of public utility.

3. (1) The limits of the Pango Peninsula are fixed as
follows—

To the North, South and West, by the sea.

To the East—

- (a) By the boundaries of property No. 3
- (b) By the boundaries of property No. 224
- (c) By the boundaries of property No. 223
- (d) By the boundaries of property No. 224
- (e) By the boundaries of property No. 105D
- (f) By the boundaries of property No. 106.

(2) The two enclaves registered as Nos. 56 and 24 and No. 60
shall not be affected by the prohibition contained in Section 2 of this
Regulation.

(3) That parcel of land known as "Norohula" and more
particularly delineated and outlined in red on the plan which may
be inspected at the District Agencies of Central District No. 1 shall
not be affected by the prohibition contained in Section 2 of this
Regulation].

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Prohibition of Land Sales (Pango Peninsula) Regulation of 1964.
