## JOINT REGULATION

No. 7 of

To provide for the Suppression of Interference with Radio Reception.

Published: Condominium Gazette No. 209.]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under Article 7 and paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

- 1. No person shall install or use any appliance, apparatus, or chicle which by its installation or use causes interference with dio reception or transmission.
- 2. (a) The Condominium Radio Engineer or such persons the Resident Commissioners may jointly appoint may at all times fing the day and in the presence of the owner or his representative for upon any premises and there inspect and test any such appliance apparatus or at any place inspect or test any such vehicle.
- (b) If any person refuses entry to his premises or permission inspect or test any appliance, apparatus or vehicle as provided in teraph (a) hereof the Court having criminal jurisdiction over person may by order authorise such entry inspection or test.
  - 3. Where any appliance, apparatus or vehicle is found to or be capable of causing interference with radio reception or mission the Resident Commissioners may by notice in writing the owner or user to deal therewith in such manner as adelate suppress such interference and stipulate the time within it shall be done.
  - Any person who shall install or use any appliance, apparatus is a contrary to Section 1 hereof, or who shall fail to comply any order issued under Section 2 (b), or who shall fail or refuse apply with any notification given in accordance with the next ling section shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction is shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20 or its equivalent at the current rate of exchange, or one month's imprisonor both such penalties.
  - Section 4 of the Vila Town Electricity Supply Joint Regula-23 of 1941 is hereby repealed.

6. This Joint Regulation may be cited as the Suppression of Interference with Radio Reception Joint Regulation No. 7 of 1960.
