 $\underline{\text{TO AMEND}}$ the Joint Consumption and Supply of Liquor Regulation N°. 10 of 1966.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 7, 8 and 59 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Amendment of s. 3 of J.R. 10 of 1966.

- 1. Section 3 of the Joint Consumption and Supply of Liquor Regulation N° . 10 of 1966 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section -
- " New Hebrideans under 21 not to consume liquor
- 3. Any New Hebridean who, being under the age of twenty-one years, procures, consumes, or, without lawful excuse, the proof whereof shall lie upon him, possesses any alcoholic liquor, commits an offence punishable on conviction before a Native Court by a fine not exceeding 2000 FNH or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange. ".

Citation and commencement

2. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Consumption and Supply of Liquor (Amendment) Regulation N° . 7 of 1974 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
