JOINT REGULATION

N° 14 of 1977

TO RESTRICT the export of cattle from the New Hebrides.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

| Consent to export of cattle | 1. No person may export live cattle from the New Hebrides without having first obtained the written consent of the Resident Commissioners to such export. |
| Offence and penalty | 2. Any person who exports live cattle without the written consent of the Resident Commissioners shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 10,000 FNH in respect of each animal exported. |
| Enforcement | 3. The Condominium Chief Veterinary Officer and officers of the Veterinary Department shall be charged with the enforcement of this Regulation. |
| Citation and commencement | 4. This Regulation may be cited as the Cattle (Export) Regulation No. 14 of 1977 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette. |
