## NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

## JOINT REGULATION

N° 14 of 1977

TO RESTRICT the export of cattle from the New Hebrides.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Consent to export of cattle

1. No person may export live cattle from the New Hebrides without having first obtained the written consent of the Resident Commissioners to such export.

Offence and penalty

2. Any person who exports live cattle without the written consent of the Resident Commissioners shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 10,000 FNH in respect of each animal exported.

Enforcement

3. The Condominium Chief Veterinary Officer and officers of the Veterinary Department shall be charged with the enforcement of this Regulation.

Citation and commencement

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Cattle (Export) Regulation No. 14 of 1977 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
