## NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

## JOINT REGULATION

No. 20 of 1976

TO AMEND the Joint Control of the Import of Animal Products Regulation No. 15 of 1967.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Amendment to s.11 of J.R. 15 of

- 1. Section 11 of the Joint Control of the Import of Animal Products Regulation No. 15 of 1967 is hereby amended
  - (a) in paragraph (a), by deleting the words
    "unless it comes from one of the countries
    prescribed in Part IV of Schedule 1 to
    this Regulation" and substituting therefor
    the words "unless such canned meat originates
    from Australia, French Polynesia, New
    Caledonia or New Zealand";
  - (b) by deleting the full-stop at the end of subparagraph (iii) of paragraph (b) and adding thereto the words "at a temperature exceeding one hundred degrees Centigrade, and "; and
  - (c) by adding the following new paragraph
    - "(c) unless it is accompanied by a certificate from a responsible official of the manufacturer stating the temperature, the pressure and the period of the sterilisation of the said meat.".

2. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Import of Animal Products ("mendment No. 2) Regulation No. 20 of 1976 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
