## JOINT REGULATION

No. 17 of 1975

TO AMEND the Joint Local Government Regulation No. 1 of 1975.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 7, 8 and 62 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Section 8 of the Joint Local Government Regulation No. 1 of 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulation") is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new sentence -

"There shall be a further right of appeal from the decisions of the Committee to the Joint Court within such period and according to such procedure as may be prescribed by the said rules.".

Citation and commencement 2. The English text of section 14 of the principal Regulation is hereby further amended by inserting immediately after the words "The decisions of every foundal shall be decided by an absolute majority of the members present" by the words "and woting".

3. The English text of section 14 of the principal Regulation is hereby further amended by inserting immediately after the words "if after two secret hallots no candidate has obtained an absolute majority" the words "of the members present".

4. The English text of section 23 of the principal Regulation is hereby amended by deleting the words "the votes cast" in subsection 1 (1) and (2) and replacing them in each case by the words "the members present".

5. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Local Government (Amendment) Regulation No. 17 of 1975 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
