JOINT REGULATION

No. 4 of 1979

TO PUT INTO EFFECT the Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 19 of 1978, passed the 15th day of December 1978, to amend the Joint Local Government Regulation No. 1 of 1975.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Articles 28 (3) and 30 of the Exchange of Notes made at London the 15th day of September 1977 between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the French Republic.

1. The Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 19 of 1978, set forth in the Schedule is hereby put into effect.

2. This Joint Regulation may be cited as the Joint Local Government (Amendment) Regulation 1979 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the New Hebrides Government Gazette.

RESOLUTION No. 19 of 1978

to amend the Joint Local Government Regulation No.1 of 1975.

THE REPRESENTATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE NEW HEBRIDES

at its sitting on the 15 December, 1978, hereby resolves and decides, in accordance with the Exchange of Notes of the 15th day of September 1977, to adopt the following measures:-

Repeal and
replacement
of S.31
JR 1 of 1975.

1. Section 31 of the Joint Local Government Regulation No.1 of 1975 is repealed and replaced as follows -

'Local
Government
Grants
Fund.

31. (1) There is hereby established a Local Government Grants Fund for assisting in defraying the expenses of Municipal Councils and Community Councils established under the provisions of this Regulation, into which Fund shall be paid such proportion of the taxes, fees and duties levied by the Government as may be determined annually by the Representative Assembly at its meeting to pass the annual Budget.

(2) In addition to the moneys referred to in subsection (1), the Government may make grants to Municipal Councils and to Community Councils, which grants shall be paid into the Local Government Grants Fund, so however, that the Minister of Internal Affairs may make such direct grants as he sees fit to any Municipal Council or Community Council.

(3) The Local Government Grants Fund shall be managed by a Committee appointed in accordance with Rules made by the Minister of Internal Affairs, which Rules shall provide that the Committee will include representatives of the Government, of the Municipal Councils and Community Councils and of the Representative Assembly.

(4) Until such time as the Minister of Internal Affairs may otherwise determine, all decisions of the Local Government Grants Fund Committee shall be subject to his approval.
