JOINT REGULATION

No. 37 of 1975

TO AMEND the Joint Liquor Licensing Regulation No. 18 of 1968.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 7 and 59 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

New s.9B added to J.R. No. 18 of 1968 1. The Joint Liquor Licensing Regulation No. 18 of 1968 as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulation") is hereby further amended by inserting immediately after section 9A the following new section -

"Pleasure Boat Licences 9B. No person shall sell or supply liquor to any person on any pleasure boat unless he has first obtained a Pleasure Boat Licence (Schedule N) permitting the sale or supply of liquor to any person for consumption on such pleasure boat in accordance with such conditions as may be prescribed by the District Agents and endorsed thereon . " .

Amendment of s.19 of principal Regulation 2. Section 19 of the principal Regulation is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the number "9A" the number "9B".

New Schedule Nadded to incipal Regulation

3. The principal Regulation is hereby further amended by adding immediately after Schedule M thereto the following new Schedule -

of
being the owner/operator of the Pleasure Boat

is hereby authorised to sell alcoholic liquor to any person for consumption on the said pleasure boat in accordance with the following conditions, that is to say - until 31st December

Citation and commencement

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Regulation No. 37 of 1975 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
