

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

N° 3 of 1974

TO PRESCRIBE the rates of allowances for assessors of the Native Courts.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 8:14 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Allowances
for time
in Court

1. The following allowances shall be paid to assessors and supplementary assessors of the Native Courts for time spent by them sitting in any Court

- (a) for each whole day - 500 FNH
- (b) for each morning or part thereof (up to 1.00 p.m.) - 300 FNH
- (c) for each afternoon or part thereof (from 1.00 p.m. onwards) - 300 FNH

or the equivalent thereof in each case in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange.

Accommodation
allowances

2. When any assessor or supplementary assessor is obliged for the purpose of attending sittings of a Native Court to spend any night at a District Station or at some other place so distant from his home as to make his return impracticable he shall be entitled to free accommodation in the Government Rest House and if no such accommodation is available to a payment in lieu thereof at the rate of 200 FNH per night or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange ;

Provided that no separate meal allowance shall be paid in respect of such overnight accommodation :

And provided that the District Agent presiding over the Native Court concerned may authorise a higher payment if he is satisfied that such sum is insufficient to cover reasonable accommodation costs.

Meal allowances

3. If it is not practicable for an assessor or supplementary assessor attending sittings of a Native Court beyond midday to return home for a midday meal the same shall be provided for him at Government expense or failing this he shall receive a meal allowance of 100 FNH or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars at the official rate of exchange.

4. This Regulation may be cited as the joint Native Courts (Allowances of Assessors) Regulation N°. 3 of 1974 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
