

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 19 of 1976

TO AMEND the New Hebrides (Import Duties) Regulation No. 12 of 1914, as amended.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2, 5 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Section 30 of the New Hebrides (Import Duties) Regulation No. 12 of 1914 (the French text which is numbered Joint Regulation No. 17 of 1914) is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section -

"30. Any goods which have not been declared, or which have not been removed from the wharf within two months from the date on which customs duties became due and payable may be seized by the Controller of Customs and, after due notice has been given, sold by auction. The proceeds of such sale shall be credited to the Condominium Treasury after deduction of customs duties, quay dues and the expenses of unloading and storage, and any expenses incurred by the Joint Administration in connection with such auction sale. " .

2. This Regulation may be cited as the New Hebrides (Import Duties) (Amendment) Regulation No. 19 of 1976 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
