## JOINT REGULATION

FURTHER TO AMEND the Joint Public Order Regulation No. 11 of 1974.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Amendment of section 13A JR11 of 1974.

1. Section 13A of the Joint Public Order Regulation No. 11 of 1974 (in this Regulation referred to as the "principal Regulation") is amended by adding the following words at the end -

"and any person who contravenes any such prohibition shall be guilty of an offence".

Amendment of section 18
JR11 1974.

2. Section 18 of the principal Regulation is amended by adding the following subsection at the end -

"(4). The competent court may on the conviction of any person for an offence against this Regulation punishable by imprisonment for two years or more, in addition to any other sentence, make an order prohibiting that person for a period not exceeding five years from residing in any part or parts of the New Hebrides. ".

Amendment of Schedule JR11 1974.

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulation is amended by adding the following item immediately after item 13 -

"13A. Contravening order of prohibition

Imprisonment for one year or a fine of 50,000 FNH or both".

Short title Citation and commencement.

- 4. (1) This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Public Order (Amendment) Regulation 1977 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
- (2) This Regulation, the principal Regulation and the Joint Public Order (Amendment) Regulation No. 26 of 1975 shall be read as one and may be cited together as the Public Order Regulations 1974 to 1977.
