**LIQUOR LICENSING (PROHIBITION OF SALE)**  
**ORDER NO.37 OF 1997**

An Order to prohibit the sale and supply of liquor throughout the islands of TORBA Province in the Republic of Vanuatu, in the interest of the public, peace and good order during TORBA Local Government Council Elections.

**IN EXERCISE** of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [CAP. 52], I, **ROBERT DAVID KARIE**, Minister of Home Affairs and Decentralisation, hereby make the following order: -


**SALE OF LIQUOR THROUGHOUT TORBA PROVINCE**

1. The sale, supply and distribution of alcoholic Liquor at or on or from Stores and Licensed Premises throughout the islands of TORBA Province in the Republic of Vanuatu whether for consumption on or off the premises is hereby prohibited from half-past seven o'clock in the morning (7.30 a.m) of Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September, 1997 until half past seven o'clock (7.30 a.m) in the morning of Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> September, 1997.

**COMMENCEMENT**

2. This Order shall come into force on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> September, 1997.
