CHAPTER 162

THE DISCONTINUANCE OF IRREGULAR INDUSTRIAL ACTION OR INDUSTRIAL ACTION ORDER NO.37 OF 1993.

An Order to discontinue the irregular industrial action or industrial action taken by the members of the Vanuatu Public Service Association or any other registered Union.

In Exercise of the Power conferred by Section 34 of the Trade Dispute Act (CAP 162), I, CHARLIE NAKO, Minister of Home Affairs hereby make the following Order:-

DISCONTINUANCE OF IRREGULAR INDUSTRIAL ACTION OR INDUSTRIAL ACTION

1. No person or a member of a class of persons specified in Section 2 of this Order shall during the period for which this Order remains in force, call, organise, procure or finance a strike, or any irregular industrial action, industrial action, or threaten to do so.

APPLICATION OF ORDER

2.(1) Section 1 applies to all Public Servants who are members of the Vanuatu Public Service Association and who are currently taking part in the irregular industrial action or any member of any registered Union.

2.(2) Any person who acts in contravention of the provision of this Order or fails to comply with any directions contained therein shall be guilty of an Offence:

Provided that to prosecution in respect of such Offence shall be invited except by or at the instance of, or with the written consent of the Attorney General.

COMMENCEMENT

3. This Order shall come into Force on the date of signature and shall remain in Force until the 30th days of January 1994 unless earlier revoked.
